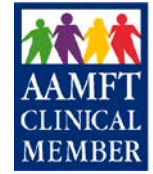

Dr. Harris has been involved in the practice of psychotherapy in South Carolina since 1975. He has been in the private practice of marriage and family therapy in the Upstate since 1989. Dr. Harris received his clinical training in marriage, family, and sex therapy from the Marriage Council of Philadelphia¹ (post-Doctorate) in 1988. His Doctorate in Child Development and Family Studies from Purdue University was awarded in 1988; his Masters of Arts in Education in School Psychology from Wake Forest University in 1975, and his Bachelors of Science in Psychology from Wofford College in 1973.

Dr. Harris holds South Carolina licensure as a Marriage and Family Therapist (LMFT), a Professional Counselor (LPC), and licensure as a supervisor for both LMFT and LPC.

Dr. Harris maintains two private practices: a general marriage and family therapy practice which focuses on adjustments to specific life changes encountered by individuals, couples and families, and a specialty practice that centers on the prevention, assessment (therapeutic and forensic) and treatment of emotional trauma, specifically Posttraumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD).
